## REGISTRATION CHECK LIST

- Please register each person attending camp individually (Example: If an adult is attending a session along with a child, each individual needs to complete a registration, health form, and any other applicable release forms.)
- Choose the Camp, Session, and Price that is appropriate for your camper and family. Families are strongly encouraged to select a week when campers can attend the entire session without interruption.
- As you select a camp session, the grade listed is the grade your camper is enrolled in as of January 2011.
- Please call or email us if you have questions about camp sessions or registration.

## ONLINE REGISTRATION

- A deposit of at least 1/3 of the cost of camp is required for online registration. Please ensure that all pertinent payment details are listed, including price selection, local church support, and/or request for conference scholarship.
- You will receive a confirmation and health form electronically within 24 hours of registering online.
- Camper letters, including session-specific information, a to-bring checklist, and any applicable release forms will be sent to you electronically or by mail after May 15th and prior to camp.

# Payment Information

As non-profit ministries, our Nebraska UM camps need to cover the cost of running high quality, spiritually enriching programs. The true cost of a week-long camp is between \$300 and \$400, depending on the program. At the same time, we understand the financial stress that many families face and are committed to making our programs available to all campers, regardless of financial situation. Realizing that families have differing abilities to pay and that you know your financial situation better than we do, we have instituted a voluntary personal pricing program. On the registration, you will find three different prices listed for each session. You get to choose the one that best fits your family's ability to pay. **The price you choose in no way influences the experience campers receive.** Please call us if you have questions about financial arrangements.

### Price A

is a heavily subsidized rate and does not reflect the true cost of operation.

### Price B

is a partially subsidized rate for families that can afford to pay a little more.

### Price C

is the least subsidized rate and more accurately accounts for the true cost of operation.

**100% of all fees are used for the direct cost of camp and fund program and facility improvements.**

## HOW DO I SELECT MY PRICE?

This program is voluntary, requires no additional paperwork, **and in no way influences the experience campers receive.** Simply choose the rate that is appropriate for your family. **Families are expected to pay a deposit of at least 1/3 of the cost of camp at the time of registration. The balance is due prior to arrival at camp. (Please Note: If you are receiving support from your local church, another local organization, or requesting a conference scholarship, please select Price A.)**

## HOW ARE THE RATES SUBSIDIZED?

We are able to offer subsidized rates and personal pricing because of generous contributions from the people of the Nebraska Conference of the United Methodist Church, as well as many other donors, staff and friends.

## FAMILY CONTRIBUTION

Families are expected to pay a deposit of at least 1/3 of the cost of camp at the time of registration. The deposit will hold a spot for the camper until the full fee is received.

## LOCAL CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP

We encourage your local church to help you pay for camp! Please contact your pastor to ask about support from your local church or another local organization. On your registration form, please list the name of the organization providing financial support, how much of the cost of camp they are providing, and if the camp needs to send them an invoice. **(Please Note: If you are receiving support from your local church, another local organization, or requesting a conference scholarship, please select Price A.)**

## CONFERENCE SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are intended for campers and families who would not be able to attend without this assistance. Conference scholarships are limited and not to exceed 1/3 of the cost of camp. At the same time, we understand the financial stress that many families face and **are committed to making our programs available to all campers, regardless of financial situation.** Therefore, special consideration will be made if needed. **(Please Note: If you are receiving support from your local church, another local organization, or requesting a conference scholarship, please select Price A.)**

## CANCELLATION POLICY

If you cancel 7 days prior to a session, you will be issued a refund minus 1/3 registration deposit when we receive your written request. With less than 7 days notice, no refund will be issued. If you cancel due to illness or family emergency, the 7-day notice is not required. You will receive a full refund after we receive a written request.
